- Please note that the only requests for a particular flight that will be granted are those which are covered in Chapter 1, Section 6, Paragraph 12 of *Regulations and Guidelines for AKC Hunting Tests for Retrievers*. Requests for multiple handlers to be placed in the same flights for logistics reasons will be honored *if possible*.
- Bitches in season are not allowed on the test grounds. ***It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to assure his female dog is not in season.***
