2009 HRC Quad Upland Tests and Youth Hunt Extravaganza

Welcome friends and neighbors!

We are pleased to invite you to our 5th annual Quad-Upland Hunt Tests and Youth Hunt Extravaganza. This year's tests are being held at the Dyer Ranch, located on CR 446 near Navasota, TX. Please be respectful of the grounds, stay on the roads, park in designated areas, pick up trash and take care to leave the ranch in good, clean condition. Be sure to take a moment during the weekend to thank the land owner, Eddie Dyer, for his generosity in letting us use his wonderful property.

Good, hot lunches will be available free of charge both days at the HQ area. BCSRC will also host a free tailgate party Saturday evening.

This year we are very excited to offer another Youth Hunt Test Extravaganza on Saturday morning beginning at approximately 9:00 a.m. In this test, any handler aged 16 or under is eligible to run any dog in a Started or Seasoned test. UKC points are not given, but the Junior Handler is given the chance to run a dog, earn a ribbon, and learn to love "the game." There are also prizes, fun games, and activities included on the agenda. The entry fee is only \$5.00; please fill out a premium for each Youth handler and submit using the instructions printed on it. Ducks will be used on the Youth Hunt Tests and Standard HRC rules will be used by the judges.

The BCSRC will provide shooters for the Upland tests. Only members who follow safe firearm and hunting practices will be used.

Please note, alcoholic beverages are NOT to be consumed until after the last dog has completed its run each day.

Secretary notes:

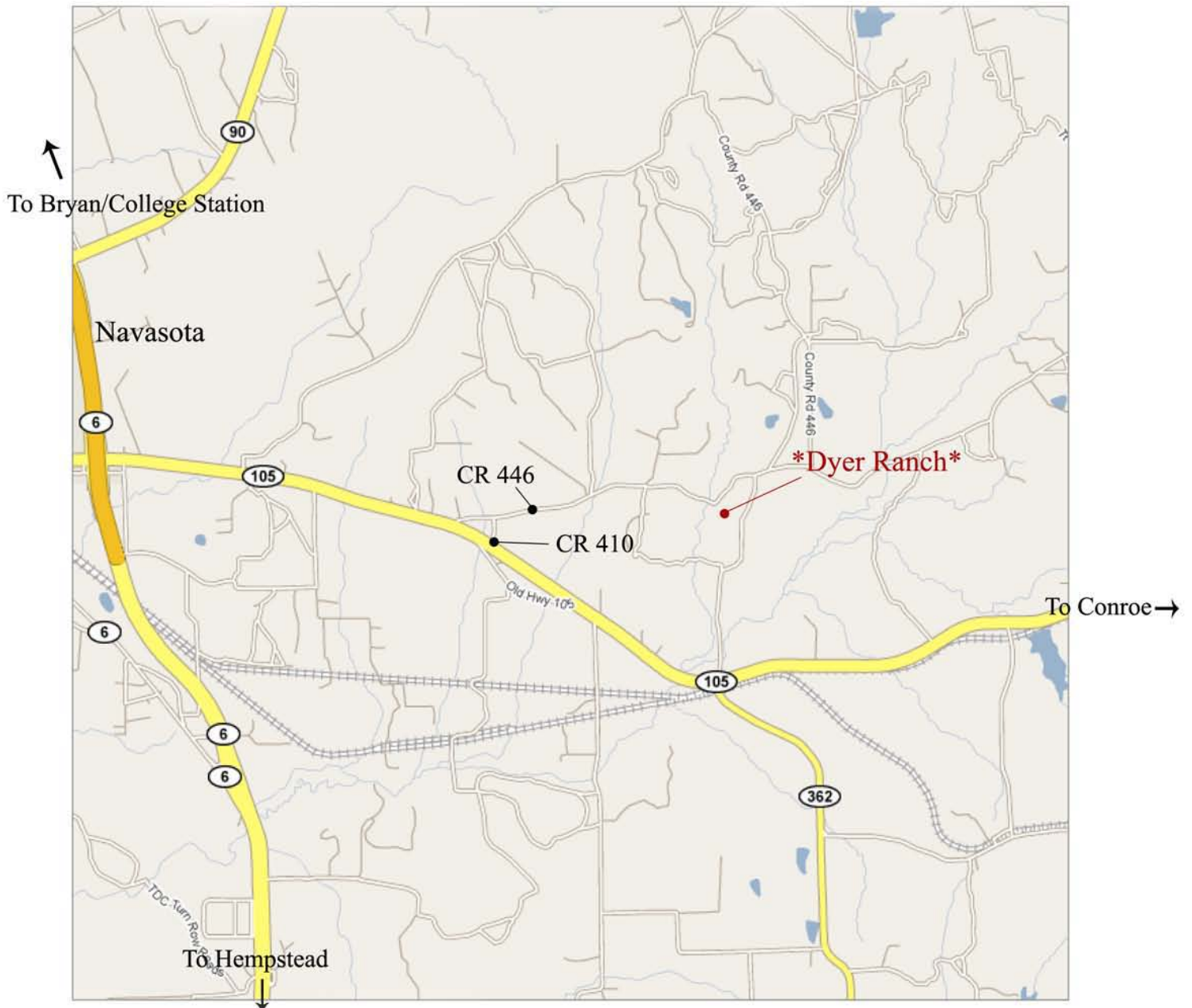

Directions from Bryan College Station:

Hwy 6 south to Navasota, take 105 east. Go approx 3.3 miles and turn left on CR 410. Follow until reaching CR 446, then turn right. Follow until you see our sign on the right. You will drive up a hill to a gate and see us from there.

From Conroe:

Travel 105 toward Navasota approx 40 miles. Turn right on CR 410 and follow until reaching CR 446. Turn right and follow a couple of miles. Watch for our sign on the right.

From Houston:

Hwy 6 to Hempstead, then Navasota. Exit 105 east and go approx 3.3 miles. Turn left on CR 410 and follow to CR 446. Turn right and follow a couple miles until you see our sign on the right
